Foster Care

Right now, about 600,000 children in the United States live in foster homes. But there are thousands more children needing a caring, Christian foster family. By becoming a Buckner foster parent, you can make a difference for children who have experienced family crisis and trauma and may have a history of abuse, neglect or abandonment.

Foster to Adopt

As a Buckner foster parent, you may want to discover the joy of permanently adding a child to your family. Our foster-to-adopt services offer you the possibility to adopt foster children who reside in your home.

Domestic Infant Adoption

For families in Texas, the domestic infant adoption program places newborns with Christian couples. As an open



adoption program, Buckner works with birth parents during the pregnancy to determine a plan for the baby's future. If they make an adoption plan, they choose the adoptive family. Then, with

Buckner's assistance, the birth parents and the adoptive family will build a plan for openness for the life of their child.

Waiting Texas Children

At any given time, there are children available for adoption through the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services. These children have lived in traditional foster homes or residential programs, and for any number of reasons their parents' rights have been terminated. Buckner can help facilitate the adoption of older children with appropriate counseling and support.

International Adoption

For families in all 50 states, Buckner offers the opportunity to adopt internationally. Buckner is an established and Hague-accredited international adoption program which focuses on placing orphans in permanent, Christian adoptive families.
